The Terrell L. Scruggs Scholarship honors lifetime Transylvania County resident and community leader Terry Scruggs. Terry graduated from Brevard High School and attended both Mars Hill College and Appalachian State University where he received undergraduate and master's degrees respectively. This scholarship passes on his enthusiasm and commitment to both Transylvania County and education by awarding a student or students a scholarship valued at up to \$1,500 to pay exclusively for tuition to the community college, college, or university of the student's choice.

Eligible applicants must meet the following guidelines:

- 1. Must be a graduating senior from one of the three Transylvania Co. Public High Schools.**
- 2. Applications must be typed or written in ink to assure legibility.**
- 3. Attach a copy of your high school transcript.**
- 4. A copy or copies of the Letter of Acceptance from your college or university.**
- 5. Applications are due by Noon on or before Friday, April 15th, 2016.**
- 6. Complete the entire application. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.**
- 7. Three (3) completed recommendation forms need to be attached in sealed envelopes.**
- 8. Completed applications can be submitted in ONE of THREE ways:**
 - A. Turned into the counselor by noon ON or BEFORE April 15th, 2016**
 - B. Hand delivered to Brevard City Hall by 5:00pm ON or BEFORE April 15th, 2016**
 - C. Mail your application, assuring it is postmarked by April 15th, 2016 to:**
