The City of Brevard is beginning the studies and designs for the replacement of the Railroad Avenue Bridge, Bridge Number 102 over Kings Creek. The project design process is anticipated to be completed in 2016; construction is not scheduled at this time.

CDM Smith, a transportation engineering consultant on this project for the City of Brevard and its sub-consultants, CH Engineering, Sungate Design Group, and Summit Design and Engineering Services, will perform land surveying along the project corridor and advance soil borings in the vicinity of the existing bridge. The purpose of the surveys and borings is to obtain field data to develop the final design plans. Representatives of the project team will be wearing safety vests and carrying proper identification at all times.

Engineers, surveyors, geologists, and others representing the City of Brevard will also be working on or near your property for the next several months collecting data necessary for the design of the new bridge. The specific area in which City of Brevard representatives will be working does not necessarily indicate the final location or extent of the proposed improvements.
