


Bracken Preserve Trail Map



Trails in Bracken Preserve are open to hiking and biking. Hunting is not allowed on the property but is in Pisgah National Forest, and licensed hunters may pass through Bracken with unloaded weapons to access the game lands within Pisgah. Official hours of Bracken Preserve are from dawn to dusk. Groups may apply for a free night-use permit to access the area after dark. For a permit or any other questions, please call the City of Brevard Planning Department at 828-885-5630.

Directions (shown in pink below)


- From downtown head west on Main Street,
- Turn right on Oaklawn Avenue,
- Turn left on Probart Street for 7/10 of a mile,
- Take a right on Music Camp Road,
- After 3/10 of a mile Music Camp Road becomes Pinnacle Road,
- Continue straight onto Pinnacle Road, which turns to gravel,
- Continue 2/10 of a mile up Pinnacle which ends at the Bracken Preserve parking lot.
