Whereas, January 11th, 2021 marks the Centennial Anniversary of the Waightstill Avery Chapter, National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution; and

Whereas, Waightstill Avery Chapter was named for the Revolutionary War ancestor of local resident, Miss Annie Jean Gash, and

Whereas, these Daughters have ceaselessly honored the Patriots and veterans of Transylvania County, and
